Subject:- Compliance orders In Appeals No. CIC-RM-C-2013-000564-SA-MP.

Sir.

Reference is invited to the CIC letter no CIC-RM-C-2013-000364-SA-MP dated 03.01.2018. In this communication, it was stated that "the present Complaint is dismissed with the direction to the respondent authority to prepare a list of the RTI applications filed by the Complainant along with the response of the department and upload the same in their official website".

In this connection, it is to inform that the order under reference was endorsed to the deemed PIO for implementation. However, the deemed PIO does not maintain the RTI Applications data applicant wise. Therefore, the decision could not be implemented. Further. the deemed PIO i.e. Prof. C. R. Babu has also mentioned in his reply dated 30.01.2018 that "the direction of Hon'ble Commission is non-compliable because no such record in maintained by us, as this is not mandated to be maintained under the RTI Act 2005". It is accordingly, submitted that since the data required to be provided is not maintained, the relevant clause of the decision requiring uploading of the RTI applications of the applicant may kindly be dropped.

It is further stated that as a matter of policy, the University otherwise also does not upload the RTI applications of the applicant because of following reasons:-

- 1. Limitation of space of the website. The University received almost 1500 applications annually and uploading of applications received under RII and their responses would take up a lot of space, which may not be a feasible proposition.
- 2. Many a times, the applicant shares personal information in the RTI application. Placing the same in public domain would not be in the spirit of RTI as defined in Section 8(1)(i) and 8(1)(e).

The request for dropping the clause requiring uploading of all the applications of the concerned applicant along with their responses is reiterated please, in view of the explanation provided.
