

**UNIVERSITY OF DELHI**  
**(Scholarship Cell)**

- (1) There shall be one scholarship\* called "Datia Darbar Endowment Scholarship", of the value of Rs. 125/- p.m.\*\* payable out of the annual income accruing on the Datia Darbar Endowment fund. The Scholarship shall be awarded to the meritorious student who joins the M.A. 1<sup>st</sup> year course in Economics in the University and is in need of financial assistance in pursuing his/her further studies.
- (2) The scholarship shall be awarded once in two years.
- (3) The scholarship shall be tenable ordinarily for one year but may be renewed for the second year if the progress at studies of the scholar has been satisfactory.
- (4) If it should appear at any time that a scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of gross misconduct he shall, after due warning in writing, be reported by the Head of the Department to the Academic Council who may reduce, suspend or withdraw his/her scholarship.
- (5) (a) No student shall be eligible for this scholarship if he/she already holds a scholarship awarded by Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or a private body or any freeship.  
(b) In case a scholar under this endowment accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be required to surrender this scholarship and shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of this scholarship from the date he/she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
- (6) Any amount accruing from interest from the endowment and not spent in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.

**REGULATIONS:**

- a. Applications for scholarship should reach the Head of the Department of Economics giving detailed information on the prescribed form obtained from the Department of Economics, Delhi School of Economics, by the date mentioned in the Notification issued in this respect by the Head of the Department.
- b. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of the Committee constituted as follows:
  - (i) Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences
  - (ii) Head of the Department of Economics
  - (iii) One Senior Professor of the Department of Economics
- c. The payment of the scholarship amount will be made to the scholar through the Head of the Department of Economics on the presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship or financial assistance from any other source.
