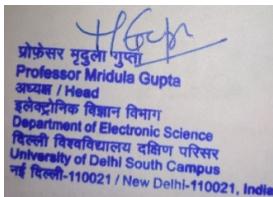
**Invitation of applications for the Appointment of Guest Faculty in the

Applications are invited under all categories for the appointment of Guest Faculty for the teaching of M.Tech. (Microwave Electronics) and M.Sc.(Electronics) courses in the Department of Electronic Science, University of Delhi South Campus. The teaching is likely to take place through online mode or in physical classroom mode as per Covid-19 restrictions for educational institutions announced by the Govt. of India. Further the period of active service spent on pursuing research degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/ promotion.

****In case, the Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign University/Institution** the Institution has to have a ranking among top 500 in the world University ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) The Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) The Academic Ranking Of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).
