QUALIFICATION AND OTHER DETAILS

Director Physical Education

Eligibility (A or B)

A

- (i) A Master's Degree in Physical Education and Sports or Physical Education or Sports Science with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- (ii) Record of having represented the University/ College at the inter-university/ inter-collegiate competitions or the State and/ or national championship.
- (iii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the "University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Provided that the award of degree to candidates registered for the Ph.D. Programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ By-laws/ Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree. All such Ph.D., candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of the NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in University/ College/ Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in the regular mode.
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners.
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voice of the candidate has been conducted.
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a referred journal.
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conference/ seminars sponsored/ funded/ supported by the UGC/ICSSR/ CSIR or may similar agency.

Note:

- (i) The fulfillment of these conditions (a) to (e) is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affair) of the University Concerned.



- B** An Asian game or commonwealth games medal winner who has a degree at least at Post-Graduation level.

Physical Fitness Test Norms

- a) Subject to the provisions of these Regulations, all candidates who are required to undertake the physical fitness test shall be required to produce a medical certificate certifying that he/she is medically fit before undertaking such tests.
- b) On production of such certificate mentioned in sub-clause (a) above, the candidate would be required to undertake the physical fitness test in accordance with the following norms:

Instructions for filling application form

1. The candidates are instructed to read carefully the detailed instructions before filling the offline form.
2. College will accept the application form through offline mode only. Applications other than offline mode will be not be accepted and rejected summarily.

4. Only short listed candidates who are found apparently eligible based on the details given in the application form will be called for an interview.
5. The date of interview will be notified on the college website. Interview call letter will not be sent by Post. Candidates are required to check the college website on regular basis.

General Instructions

1. The post will be filled as per the Recruitment Rules of the University of Delhi. The qualifications and other service conditions shall be such as prescribed by the University of Delhi from time to time.
2. Those who are in employment with State/ Central Govt./ PSU, must submit a "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" from the employer at the time of submission of application / verification of documents. Failure to submit NOC by due date will lead to cancellation of candidature.
3. Application fee for UR/OBC/EWS category - Rs 500/- . No application fee will be charged from applicants from SC, ST, PwD and Women Applicants. **Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.** Those apply can pay the requisite fee in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "Principal, Dyal Singh Evening College" payable at New Delhi.
4. Candidates should possess the prescribed educational qualification and experience as on the closing date of application.
5. Canvassing in any form will be treated as disqualification.
6. Applications which do not meet the criteria given in this advertisement & / or incomplete applications are liable to be summarily rejected.
7. Candidates should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered, fabricated or suppress any material/ information while submitting the application and self-certified copies/testimonial.
